Spending quality time together as a family not only builds trust but also creates a fertile ground for reconnecting and growing spiritually.

Each family activity organized by the parish, which involves joint participation of a Youth Group and their parents, should begin with an Akathist hymn dedicated to a saint or holy event, led by the parish priest. Following this prayerful beginning, fun and engaging activities can follow to further enhance the spirit of togetherness.
